

**NORTHWEST NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION  
GENERAL MEETING  
October 15, 2009**

Meeting called to order at 7:00

At the beginning of the meeting, City Council President Joe Shogan asked to talk to the association explaining he had a meeting with the City Council earlier in the day. The results of the meeting were positive and stated that all "families" have differences, but all is good in the Council.
